SYNOPSIS


Alice in Summer Wonderland is a play based on the 1865 novel 'Alice's Adventures in Wonderland' By Lewis Carroll. Narrated by the 'not so imaginary' Cheshire Cat, the story follows a young girl, Alice, who falls asleep in a meadow beside her sister Ruth. She begins to dream about a White Rabbit, who she follows and eventually falls down a rabbit hole. Alice wakes up to find herself in Wonderland. She stumbles upon a caterpillar and her flowers, who reprimand her for being too loud. Luckily, she meets the rabbit she was looking for and pleads with the rabbit to help her find her way home. Rabbit insists she will do so but only after they attend the Duchess' tea party. Meanwhile, the Mad Hatter is being held captive by The Queen of Hearts and her trusty guards for beating her at her own game of croquet. After escaping the queen's clutches, Hatter seeks refuge in the Duchess' castle. Here she meets Alice and together they explore themes of identity, friendship, morality and absurdity. Alice eventually wakes up to find herself back in the meadow with her sister and shares in delight her adventures in summer wonderland.
